
Safe Harbor staff and volunteers joined together to create a fun, festive night for our clients and their children at our annual christmas Party.





# Sale Hazbozí s 18th Take Back the Night Rally Detober 17th, 2011

### **Donate Your Old Cell Phone!**

At Safe Harbor, we keep a supply of donated cell phones with chargers that can be given to clients who may have no other means of contacting the police in an emergency.

Can't find the charger? That's okay! We also accept phones that are missing chargers and batteries. We'll even take that broken cell phone off your hands!

Just drop them by our office during regular business hours, Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm.
